

WASTE SEPARATION



NATIONALPARK CHALETS



Waste separation is done in three stages:

Stage 1:

In the cupboard of your kitchen you collect:

- metal (caps and lids)
- plastic and packaging material
- residual waste (e.g. food)
- collect glass and paper / cardboard elsewhere in your chalet

Stage 2:

You can empty the full containers from the kitchen into the green dustbins * that are located elsewhere in your chalet:

- the small green container with yellow lid: plastic and packaging material
- the small green container with green lid: paper and cardboard
- the small green container with blue lid: metal
- the large grey container outside the front door: residual waste and bio/organic-waste

* these are usually found in the technical room of your chalet or in the carport.

Stage 3:

During your stay or at departure, you are supposed to empty the three green containers in one of the two waste collection stations on the site.

- the contents of the green container with yellow lid: large green container with yellow lid
- the contents of the green container with green lid: large green container with red lid
- the contents of the green container with blue lid: blue container

Bring glass to the waste collection station in front of house 45 or at the NPC Lounge, sorting to white and other.
